TO: ALL MODEL 47 OPERATORS

SUBJECT: NEW TAIL ROTOR HUB AND BLADES

THIS IS A REMINDER THAT THE MODEL 47 SERIES HELICOPTERS (47G-2A, 47G-2A1, 47G-3, 47G-3B, 47G-3B1, 47G-3B2, 47G-4, 47G-4A, 47G-5, 47J-2 AND 47J-2A) HAVE A NEW TAIL ROTOR HUB AND BLADE REQUIRED BY SERVICE BULLETIN 47-76-2 DATED 2-13-76. THIS NEW DESIGN HAS A GREATER FATIGUE MARGIN AND THE RETIREMENT LIFE OF THE BLADES IS PRESENTLY 2500 HOURS. THE OLD DESIGN BLADE IS LIMITED TO 600 HOURS. THERE HAVE BEEN NO CRACKS OR FAILURES REPORTED ON THE NEW BLADES.

WE HAVE HAD SEVERAL RECENT ACCIDENTS APPARENTLY DUE TO OLD DESIGN TAIL ROTOR BLADE FAILURE, THEREFORE, BHT STRONGLY URGES THAT OPERATORS RE-EVALUATE THEIR POSITION IN REFERENCE TO S.B. 47-76-2. KITS MAY BE ORDERED FROM YOUR NORMAL BHT SPARES OUTLET. REFER TO S.I. 428 FOR PARTS REQUIRED FOR YOUR PARTICULAR MODEL(S).

BHT HAS ESTABLISHED A NEW PROGRAM TO CERTIFY MODELS 47G
AND 47G-2 WITH THE NEW DESIGN HUB AND BLADES. THIS WILL
REQUIRE SPECIAL STRAIN GAGE FLIGHT TESTS WHICH BELL WILL
CONDUCT TO ACHIEVE CERTIFICATION. OPERATORS OF BELL MODEL
47G'S AND 47G-2'S WILL BE ADVISED WHEN CERTIFICATION IS
ACHIEVED.

IN THE MEANTIME, OPERATORS OF 47G'S, G-2'S AND OTHER 47
MODELS INCORPORATING THE (OLD TYPE) TAIL ROTORS MUST
COMPLY WITH SERVICE BULLETIN NO. 143SB AND THE APPLICABLE
MAINTENANCE AND OVERHAUL INSTRUCTIONS, CONCERNING FREQUENT
INSPECTION AND LIFE.
